Is there a cost associated with the program?

There is no cost to families at all. This voluntary program is designed to help parents and caregivers be the best they can be, teaching them strategies that will help prepare their children for school.

Do parent educators have to come into homes?

Parent educators will work with families whenever and wherever they feel most comfortable. As part of the school's literacy initiative, the Taliaferro County schools media center has a special area that can be used as a meeting place for visits.
