The Frazier School District has been dealing with an increase in absenteeism in our elementary school. Please know that we are taking multiple measures to ensure that the building(s) are thoroughly cleaned and sanitized on a daily basis.

We have implemented the following:

- Increased custodial staff
- Weekend cleaning
- Daily Disinfecting
- Principal Communication Email
- Additional Nursing Staff
- Student Handwashing Program (Steratore Sanitary)
- Pennsylvania Department of Health Communications

We have been in direct communications with the Pennsylvania Department of Health who has pointed out that many school districts across the Commonwealth are dealing with the same influx in student sickness and absences. Please know the Department of Health commended Frazier on their efforts to provide a clean and safe learning environment for our students. If there would have been a continued rise in absences, I truly would have considered having a school closure. I am continuing to monitor the situation with both the School Nurse and Building Principals.
