Robert P. McCulloch, Sr. purchased the bridge for \$2.46 million. It was meticulously disassembled in London in the late 1960s, dismantled and shipped by boat from England to the United States and then reassembled on a peninsula on Lake Havasu in 1971.

The word Havasu means blue green water in the Havasupai language.

Lake Havasu is a man-made lake formed by Parker Dam on the Colorado River.
