The Trust Fund Public Hearing was held in the Elementary School Multipurpose Room.

School Board Chairperson, Jay Duguay called the hearing to order at 6:32 PM.

Jay Duguay mentioned the Public Hearing was being held regarding the use of monies from the Equipment Expendable Trust Fund for a baseball pitching machine. The pitching machine was removed from the budget in favor of utilizing Trust Fund monies for this purchase. The original amount estimated for this purchase was three thousand, five hundred dollars (\$3,500). The cost of the pitching machine will be slightly under that estimate at three thousand, three hundred twenty-four dollars and seventy-three cents (\$3,324.73).

Jay Duguay asked for comments or questions from the Board. There were no members of the public present in person. Hearing no comments, Jay Duguay closed the public comment period of the Hearing and asked for a motion.

Tamra Ham made a motion to approve and expend three thousand, three hundred twenty-four dollars and seventy-three cents (\$3,324.73) from the Equipment Expendable Trust Fund for a baseball pitching machine. Jasmine Weeden seconded the motion. Discussion: None. Jay Duguay called a vote to approve the motion. All Board members present were in favor and the motion carried.

Jay Duguay adjourned the Public Hearing to the regularly scheduled School Board Meeting at 6:34 PM.
