The Trust Fund Public Hearing was held in the Elementary School Multipurpose Room.

School Board Chairperson, Jay Duguay called the hearing to order at 6:32 PM.

Jay Duguay mentioned the Public Hearing was being held regarding the use of monies from the Equipment Expendable Trust Fund for a baseball pitching machine. The pitching machine was removed from the budget in favor of utilizing Trust Fund monies for this purchase. The original amount estimated for this purchase was three thousand, five hundred dollars (\$3,500).
