NEW BOARD MEMBER ORIENTATION

A new member or any person designated for appointment as a new member of the Board is to be afforded the Board's and the staff's fullest measure of courtesy and cooperation. Board and staff shall make every feasible effort to assist the new member to become fully informed about the Board's functions, policies, and procedures.

- 1. The new member is to be provided with copies of all appropriate publications and aids, including the Board policy manual and publications of the State and National School Boards Associations.
- 2. The Board chairperson and/or members of the administrative staff will also provide local orientation to the new board member as necessary.

The new board member should be encouraged to attend the NH School Board Association New Member Orientation Workshop.
