What is HCCA?

- HCCA is a campus that is part of the Houston County school system that offers courses that are not available at PHS. Some are dual enrolled with Central Georgia Technical College and some are regular high school electives.
- It is located at 1311 Corder Road in Warner Robins
- You must ride the bus from PHS to HCCA.
- Each course will take two elective periods out of your schedule.

High school elective offerings

These classes are offered for high school credit only:

Artificial intelligence Pathway – 2-year program

Audio/Video Technology & Film pathway – 2-year program

Culinary Arts pathway – 2-year program

Fine Furniture/ Cabinet making pathway -2-year program

Healthcare Science Technology Pathway – 2-year program

Education as a Profession Pathway – 2-year program

- If you are interested in high school elective offerings, you do not need to fill out the CGTC application or gafutures application. These classes do not award college credit.
- You need to fill out the interest form and check the courses you are interested in taking. Make sure your parent signs the paper and return it to the counselor's office tomorrow!
- These classes are first come, first served and PHS has very few spaces awarded to us.

DE courses offered through CGTC:

- Air Conditioning Pathway – 2-year program – 24 hours of DE funding
- Auto Maintenance Pathway – 2-year program – 17 hours of DE funding
- Barbering Pathway – 1 year program – 9 hours of DE funding
- Cosmetology Pathway – 1 year program – 13 hours of DE funding
- Emergency Medical Responder Pathway – 1 year program – 11 hours of DE funding
- Cybersecurity Pathway – 1 year program – 18 hours of DE funding
- Engineering and Technology Pathway – 1 year program – 10 DE funding hours
 - You must be an upcoming junior/senior to take this course

- Fire Science: Firefighting Pathway – 2 year – 15 hours of DE funding
- Government/Public Safety Pathway – 2 year – 24 hours of DE funding
- Nurse Aide Essentials Pathway – 1 year – 10 hours of DE funding
- Information Support & Services Pathway – 1 year – 8 hours of DE funding
- Welding Pathway – 2 year – 23 hours of DE funding
- Automation Technology Pathway (previously Industrial Systems) – 2 year – 21 hours of DE funding
- Culinary Arts Pathway – 2 year – 12 hours of DE funding

- Aviation Technology Pathway – 1-year program
 - Offered at the CGTC Training Center in Macon – Transportation NOT provided
 - You must be an upcoming junior/senior to take this course
- Computer Software Engineering Pathway – 2-year program – 12 hours of DE
 - Offered through Middle Georgia State University
 - You must apply to MGA, not CGTC if you'd like to take this program
 - You must be an upcoming junior/senior to take this course
 - Please let your counselor know if this is what you'd like to do

**You are given 30 semester hours of dual enrollment funding.
If you take an HCCA course, the hours will be subtracted
from your 30 hours.**

Example:

You take Cosmetology at HCCA (13 DE Hours)

$30 - 13 = 17$ hours left

You take US History through DE at PHS (6 DE Hours)

$17 - 6 = 11$ hours

You want to take English 1101, 1102, Algebra, and Psychology through DE (12 hours)

$11 - 12 = -1$ (you'd owe \$107)

Example:

You take the Government / Public Safety Pathway (24 hours)

$$30-24 = 6$$

You take DE US History (6 DE hours)

$$6-6=0$$

You would be out of funding money and have to self pay for any other DE courses you take.

How HCCA slots are awarded:

1. You have to meet GPA guidelines
2. You must be on track to graduate
3. You must meet any age requirements
4. You must turn in all paperwork
5. First come, first served

What paperwork?

DUAL ENROLLMENT CLASSES:

- You must fill out a CGTC application even if you've done one before
- We will take care of sending your transcript to CGTC
- The gafutures funding application opens on February 26. You must fill out the Dual Enrollment funding application and have your parent complete their part.
- Please turn in the CGTC application ASAP. We will begin assigning spots on Feb. 27 based on who has completed the gafutures application.

High School elective courses:

- You sign and parent signs the form you were given today
- Bring it back to your counselor ASAP
