ONLINE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

High School Scholarship Opportunities

- Four (4) TFB Memorial/Honorary District Scholarship awarded per TFB District (52 available)
- One (1) TFB YF&R Scholarship for High School students awarded per TFB District (13 available)
- One (1) TFB Dick Mitchell Memorial Scholarship awarded

Collegiate Scholarship Opportunities

- Four (4) Mia Balko Student Teaching Scholarship (Agricultural Education) - awarded each semester
- Three (3) TFB YF&R Scholarships for Enrolled College students awarded
- One (1) TFB S.M. True, Jr. Agricultural Scholar Award awarded
- Four (4) Rural Veterinary Scholarship

When to Apply

- Applications are open now
- Applications close at **11:59 PM, March 1, 2024**

How to Apply – Online only

- All applications must be completed online. Please follow the step-by-step instructions below to access and complete TFB scholarship applications.
 1. Log into or set up an account with MyTFB. To do so visit <https://my.texasfarmbureau.org> or download the MyTFB iOS app from the App Store.
 - a. *For new accounts*, verify your membership.
 - b. Once verified, you will receive an email with a link to set up a username and password. (The email will be sent to the one that is tied to the **main member** on your TFB membership.)
 2. Members can create a profile using their membership number in MyTFB. Only one account can be created per membership, but multiple family members can access the account with the same username and password.
 3. Log in using existing membership account credentials
 4. **To access applications**, click on My Registration (*on the left-hand side of the page*) and select 2024 Texas Farm Bureau Scholarships. Next, select the blue "Click Here to Apply" button.
 - a. Siblings will use the same instructions above if applying for a scholarship in the same year
 5. Once on the Reviewr page, click on "Create an Account" found on the right-hand side of the screen. From there, thoroughly read instructions and eligibility requirements provided.
 6. Select the scholarship you wish to apply for and complete the application.
 - a. If you are applying for more than one scholarship, please follow the instructions displayed at the completion of your first application to apply for another scholarship.
 7. You will receive an email from the Reviewr system once you have successfully completed and submitted your application.

Eligibility and Required Application Documents

- You must be a Texas Farm Bureau member to apply
- You must have a myTFB account to apply
- Each scholarship has a unique set of eligibility requirements. Those requirements are located online through our TFB Website within the Youth Opportunities page: <http://texasfarmbureau.org/youth/youth-opportunities/>

Recommendations

- Print application instructions and scholarship requirement checklist prior to filling out the online application.

- Information is auto saved.
- Applications can be edited as long as the application has not been submitted.
- When uploading documents please keep the following in mind **DO NOT** include symbols in the file name
- File Names **MUST** include applicant name and indicate which file has been requested. Examples:
 - Jane Doe HS Transcript; Jane Doe ACT SAT; Jane Doe EFC
- Color portrait suggested size should be 1200 pixels wide X 1600 pixels tall (4" X 6", 300 dpi) in .jpg file format
- **Do not submit application until you are certain:**
 - All questions are answered
 - All information is correct
 - All documents have been uploaded
 - Edits cannot be made after submission

Scholarship Requirements Checklist – High School

Scholarships must be submitted on-line on or before 11:59 PM, March 1, 2024

Scholarship awards will be announced by the end of May 2024

Eligibility requirements for all High School scholarships

- Applicant must complete all questions
- Applicant must be a member of a Farm Bureau family (*membership must remain in good standing for the duration of the scholarship*)
- High school information
- High school scores and other information
- Collegiate / university information
- Other scholarships (submitted or received)
- List major agriculture leadership activities
- List other leadership activities
- Upload high school transcript
- Download blank GPA form ([GPA Form](#)) – have high school principal or counselor complete
- Upload completed GPA form
- Upload SAT / ACT Scores
- Upload FSS (FAFSA Submission Summary) if the FAFSA was submitted
- Upload a color portrait

Eligibility requirements for District/Memorial/Honorary

Total of 52 are available (4 per district)

- Applicant must complete all questions
- Must be a graduating high school senior

Eligibility requirements for Young Farmer & Rancher (High School)

Total of 13 are available (1 per district)

- Applicant must complete all questions
- Must be a graduating high school senior
- Must intend to pursue a career in agriculture

Eligibility requirements for Dick Mitchell Memorial

Total of 1 scholarship is available

- Applicant must complete all questions
- Must be a graduating high school senior
- Applicant must have attended Texas Farm Bureau Student Success Series - Thrive event in 2023.

2024 TEXAS FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP – UNWEIGHTED GPA FORM

The applicant must still submit his/her high school transcript (including Fall 2023 grades) and the SAT and/or ACT scores, in addition to this form, through the TFB online scholarship system even though information from these documents is included above.
