Spring Semester 2022

Students attempting to earn CDM during the Spring semester

for courses scheduled for the 2021-2022 school year:

*December 2021-January 2022 Parents and students will be informed of the CDM processes no later than the end of December. Counselors, teachers and administrators will provide advisement for interested students.

*January 31, 2022 - Student applications are due to your school principal.

*February 15-March 14, 2022 - Implement Phase I Assessments of CDM process-official DPI testing window for EOC/CTE courses.

*March 7-March 14, 2022 – District will report results of Phase I assessments to students and families.

*March -April 2022 - Phase II artifact work will be scheduled for students who achieve the required standard on the Phase I assessment.

*April 4-8, 2022 - RCSS will conduct district and school level artifact reviews. Content specialists will meet to review artifacts and determine results.

*April 25, 2022 – District will provide results to students/families and discuss course schedule changes. Begin a tencalendar day window for submission of appeals (May 3 – May 12, 2021).

*May 9-13, 2022 – District will conduct appeals review.

*May 20, 2022 - Finalized appeal decisions will be made and shared. Student schedules will be amended as needed.

*July 19-July 29, 2022 - Implement Phase I Assessments of CDM process-official DPI testing window for EOC/CTE courses.

Next CDM cycle begins September 2022.

*September 17-October 14, 2022 - Implement Phase I Assessments of CDM process-official DPI testing window for EOC/CTE courses.

Additional Summer CDM Opportunity Timeline for Informing for the 2022-2023 School Year.

There will be an additional opportunity reserved for students who move into the district after the Spring deadlines or who miss the Spring window due to illness or other extenuating circumstance. Summer timelines for CDM will be more difficult to accomplish both for students and administrators due to lack of flexibility of time with schedule changes at the school and district levels. Although no definitive dates have been established by the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI), the implementation of the Phase I Assessment of the CDM process and the DPI testing window has been set as the last two weeks of July, 2022. Therefore, advisement and application processes will begin in mid- June, 2022. Phase II processes will immediately follow Phase I assessments.
