CHAPTER 31 – VETERANS READINESS & EMPLOYMENT (VR&E) Discharge under Conditions other than Dishonorable, no matter the length of service (disability percentage of at least 10%)	Up to 48 months	Paid directly to the college	Subsistence allowance paid directly to the student, Book and supply voucher provided to the college
<b>CHAPTER 30 – MONTGOMERY GI BILL®</b> Honorable discharge with between 2 and 4 years of service	Up to 36 months	No tuition benefit	Monthly stipend paid directly to the student
CHAPTER 1606 – MONTGOMERY GI BILL® SELECTED RESERVE Must have completed Basic Training and committed to at least a 6-year obligation	Up to 36 months	No tuition benefit	Monthly stipend paid directly to the student
CHAPTER 35 – SURVIVORS' AND DEPENDENTS' Child or spouse of Veteran who is deceased, permanently or totally disabled due to a service-connected disability, or perished while on active duty	Up to 36 months	No tuition benefit	Monthly stipend paid directly to the student
<b>AL G.I. ANGEAP SCHOLARSHIP Alabama National Guard Members only; must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA	Reimbursed to student as "gap" aid that covers expenses not paid by other financial aid.	Paid directly to the college for the first undergrad degree	Reimbursement paid at the end of each semester
