By removing the barrier of cost, CEP ensures that every student has a fair and equal opportunity to start the day ready to learn and stay energized through the afternoon.

Meals served through this program follow USDA nutrition guidelines, providing students with balanced, wholesome options that fuel both body and mind. We encourage all families to support their children in participating in our breakfast and lunch programs—it's a simple but powerful way to help them thrive in and out of the classroom.
