Practice at Home

- Practice breaking words apart into syllables, then breaking syllables into individual sounds to spell. Use the UFLI spelling practice guide I send home each week to take what we are learning in class to apply it at home.
- For math, practice adding and subtracting numbers using a variety of different strategies. These strategies might include decomposing numbers, using a number line, or drawing the base ten form of the numbers to add or subtract.
- Practice reading an analog clock.



This Week's Agenda

Spelling: Dropping the 'e' Rule

When we add the suffix beginning with a vowel to a base word ending in an 'e', we have to drop the 'e' before adding that suffix.

- Hike -> hiking
- Poke -> poked
