

Determine A Theme

Determine a theme of a text and analyze its development over the course of the text; provide an objective summary of the text.

Text Analysis

Analyze how particular lines of dialogue or incidents in a story propel the action, reveal aspects of a character, or provoke a decision.

How Can Parents Help with Reading

- Share new words you came across in your reading and what they mean.
- Encourage your child to read for 15 minutes before going to sleep each night.
- Take reading materials with you on outings.
- Encourage your child to read while riding in the car, waiting at the doctor's office, passing time between activities.



Did You Know?

Purposely copying another's work can result in serious consequences that could include fines up to \$250,000 for each instance AND up to 5 years in jail!


Authors and creators can also file civil suits that could result in higher financial penalties.




How Can Parents Help with Math


