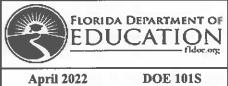

#### **Narrative Components**

The LCSB Grant proposal will include (5) expanding the use of transportation funds under ss. 1002.394, 1002.395, and 1011.68 to help cost the cost of transporting students to and from school.

- Funds will be used to provide improved access to reliable and safe transportation for students participating in public education school choices and supports innovative solutions that increase efficiency of the LCSB public school transportation.
- The LCSB grant funds will be used to purchase one van to be used by current district staff to provide daily transportation for students living in the Vilas community, which is located 15-25 miles from school.
- Up to 6 students will be provided transportation to the school of choice using the van using grant proceeds, for the entirety of the academic year, beginning from the grant award date and available van.
- The total cost of the van is \$50,998.
- The LCSB is requesting \$50,000 total, as outlined in the attached budget narrative and will make up the cost difference from other internal fund sources.
- The project outcomes will be measured quantitatively using transportation and/or student attendance logs.
