Frequently Asked Questions

Does Every 8th Grade Student Have to Apply for Signature Academies of Mobile County?

The Application process is designed for students that are interested in attending the SIGNATURE ACADEMY (Baker's is AP Capstone). Transfer and Feeder pattern students interested in taking Advanced Placement courses need to APPLY at <https://signatureacademies.schoolinsites.com/apply>. In-district students that are not planning on taking Advanced Placement will not need to APPLY. They will select their academy on campus freshmen year.

Can a Student Transfer Into Baker Under Any Academy?
