## TEACHERS TEACHING THEIR OWN CHILDREN

In the event that a parent of a child attending the school is also a teacher, the Principal shall adjust teaching assignments in order to minimize the amount of time that the teacher spends during any school day instructing his/her child. Ideally, the amount of classroom time that a teacher spends instructing his/her own child will be eliminated. Recognizing that this will not always be possible, a goal of not more than one instructional period per day will be acceptable. Exceptions will be made based on extenuating circumstances. Such exceptions shall require the approval of the Board of Trustees.
