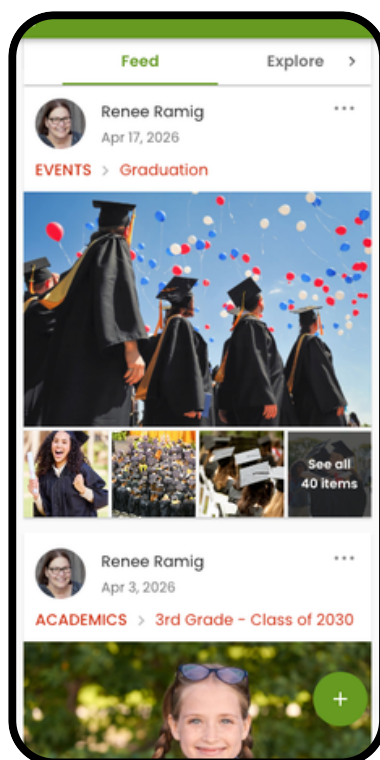

Before You Begin

Vidigami brings together the moments that make up your child's school experience in one secure place -- from classroom learning and performances to athletics and special events. A few tips to help you get the most from it:

- **Activate your account.** Vidigami is by invite only. Your school will send a Vidigami activation email.
- **Download the mobile app.** It gives you the easiest, quickest experience.
- **Favorite your child's pages.** You'll get fast access to new updates.
- **Review "Is this me?" suggestions.** If your school uses facial recognition, reviewing "Is This Me?" suggestions helps build your child's portfolio.



1. How Do I Get Started?

GOAL

After receiving your invitation and activating your account, access your school's stories from anywhere.

Download the Vidigami app from the Apple App Store (iPhone & iPad) or Google Play (Android phones & tablets). Once you've signed in, you're ready to start exploring your school's stories

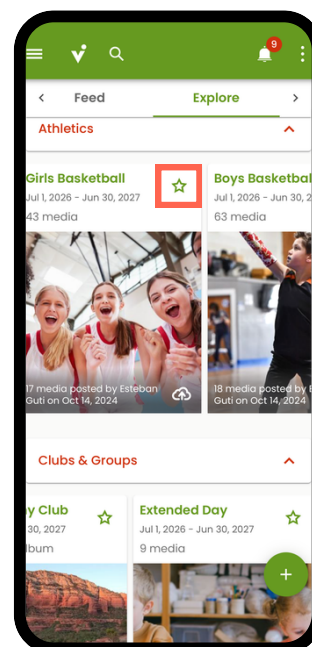
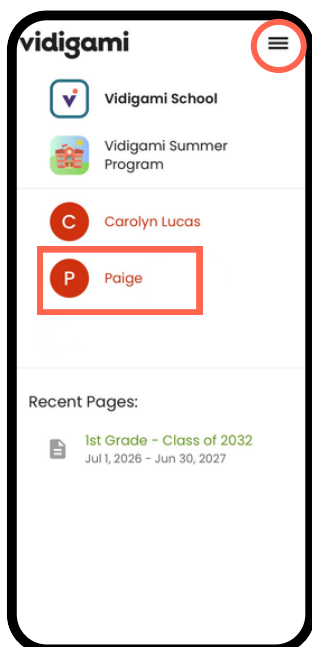
2. Finding Photos of Your Child

GOAL

Follow your child's school journey.

Tap your child's name to open their Portfolio. Here you'll find all of the photos that have been tagged or verified as your child. As new photos are added throughout the year, their portfolio continues to grow.

Tip: Use Favorites to Personalize Your Vidigami Experience

Favorite the Pages that are most relevant to your family's school experience. Then, turn on My Favorites in Feed and Explore to see content only from those Pages. You can turn My Favorites off at any time to return to the full school view.

3. Review Tagging Suggestions with "Is This Me?"

GOAL

Help build your child's portfolio.

If your school has enabled "Is This Me?", Vidigami may suggest photos that include your child. Simply review each suggestion and choose:

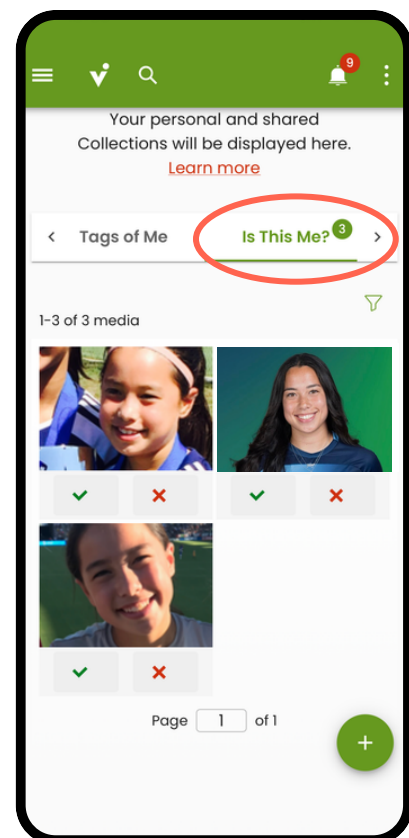
**Yes**

If it's your child.

**No**

If it isn't.

Each confirmation helps improve future suggestions and adds verified photos to your child's portfolio.

**Good to Know**

The more suggestions you review, the more complete and accurate your child's portfolio becomes over time.

4. Download Photos on your Mobile Device

GOAL

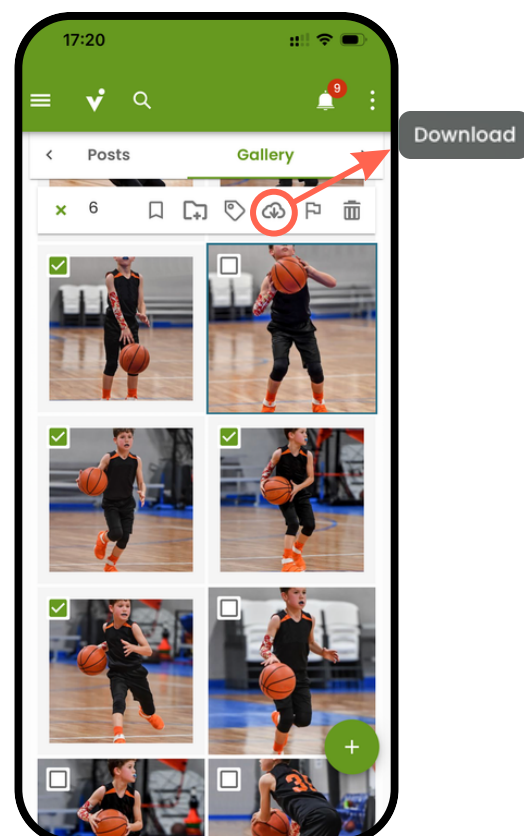
Save multiple photos to your device.

- 01 Go into an album/page gallery view.**
- 02 Select multiple images that you want to download.**
- 03 Tap the cloud icon.**
- 04 Select either Web Quality or Original Quality.**
- 05 Tap Download.**

iPhone & iPad
The photo is saved to your Photos library.

Android
The photo downloads to your device.
Tap Photo Gallery to view it.

5. How to Share Your Photos

GOAL

Contribute to your school community.

If uploading is allowed by your school, sharing your photos helps preserve the moments that teachers and staff may not always be able to capture.

- 01 Open the Vidigami app.**
- 02 Tap the plus (+) icon.**
- 03 Select Upload Media.**
- 04 Choose your photos.**
- 05 Search for the Page and choose Album**
- 06 Tap Upload.**



Your photos will be available to your school community once they've been processed or reviewed, depending on your school's settings.

Photos from games, performances, field trips, concerts, and school events help create a richer story of your child's experiences and your school community.
