With the first semester complete and the third quarter underway, I wanted to share details of an important meeting I recently participated in at BCSD200U.

On November 14th, 2024, Mrs. Rojas, Mrs. Hise, Mrs. Beaulieu, Dr. Hoffman, Mr. Sarsany and I were involved an meeting with representatives from a community mental health program called Thriveworks. This service is provided by cooperation between the Fire District and Washington Township, along with Thriveworks, the Will County Health Department, and Senior Services of Will County.

Some of the counseling services that Thriveworks provides are as followed:

- 1. Stress management counseling
- 2. Anxiety and depression counseling
- 3. Couples and family therapy
- 4. Psychiatry or medication management
- 5. Other mental health services

#### Benefits of thriveworks include are as followed:

- 1. Washington Township has a grant and is covering the cost of Washington Township for people without insurance. (Have to be a resident)
- 2. The turnaround time for a counselor is quick. Thriveworks will contact the parent's the same day.
- 3. Thriveworks offers virtual, in person, medication management, individual therapy and couples therapy.
- 4. In person locations: Joliet, Woodridge, Munster, Evergreen Park, and 3 locations in the city.
- 5. Thriveworks will make the referral for the inpatient services with students who are actively trying to hurt themselves.
- 6. The therapist that the student connects with initially will be the therapist that they will continue with.
- 7. Level 1-4: inpatient, outpatient, medication management

## **SRO'S Important Reminders**











- Please do not use your mobile devices while your vehicle is in motion on the school property or within the 20mph School Zone.
- Our entire campus, including the parking lots, is a tobacco-free zone.
- All visitors must check-in at the front office and present a government issued photo ID. If a parent or guardian for any reason does not have a US government-issued ID, the school staff member can use any form of identification and manually enter the person's name into the Raptor system.
