ARP- Homeless Grant 2022  
(ARP-Homeless Children and Youth: \$5,855.00)

Sugar Valley Rural Charter School will utilize ARP grant funds for individuals to purchase materials for students to participate in school activities and to maintain personal independence. Store cards will enable individuals to purchase clothing, school supplies, hygiene items, food, bottled water and other identified needs. Additionally, APR funds may be utilized for shoes, boots, uniform, graduation cap, and other specialties to allow participation in school based activities.

The ARP funds will ensure children and youth experiencing homelessness are integrated into normalcy of programs of the student's choice. The identified youth will participate and succeed in selected extracurricular school based opportunities. Funds may assist students with transportation, gas, bedding, and independent living items. Basic items could include laundry detergent, towel, wash cloth, hot plate, etc. It is to be noted that this is not an inclusive list.

SVRCS will purchase prepaid cards to have them on site due to the geographical location of the school. The school is located in rural Clinton County. The homeless liaison will implement a tracking system to monitor funds and store cards.. Identified students and or families will provide a signature for the store card and return a receipt of purchases to the homeless liaison..
