RGSD WELCOMES SCHOLARS BACK TO IN-PERSON LEARNING

Riverview Gardens School District will welcome scholars back to in-person learning when the 2021-2022 school year begins on Monday, Aug. 23.

Please review the Riverview Gardens School District's 2021–2022 Return to School Plan. This plan was approved by the Special Administrative Board at the June 22, 2021 board meeting. It calls for a return to in-person learning for all students and grade levels.

All new & returning K-12 students must <u>register online</u> before the start of school. Early childhood students must register in person at Michelle Obama ECAC.

The Return to School Plan is subject to change based on the guidance of the CDC, DESE and St. Louis County. RGSD is committed to providing a safe and healthy learning environment for all students and staff.
