This year, we're offering a wonderful selection of hands-on learning experiences designed to inspire creativity, build practical skills, and connect students with cultural traditions and nature.

- **NAVAJO WEAVING:** Students are learning the fundamentals of traditional Navajo weaving, including loom setup, basic techniques, and basic pattern design. This program celebrates Indigenous cultural heritage while developing fine motor skills, patience, and artistic expression.
- **BASIC PAINTING:** Perfect for young artists of all levels! Students are exploring color theory, brushwork techniques, and various painting styles. They'll create original artwork while building confidence in self-expression.
- **INDOOR/OUTDOOR GARDENING:** Learn to grow plants year-round in your home!
