

Family Engagement Goal	Strategies
1. Facilitate family-to-family support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a safe, respectful, and supportive environment • Provide opportunities to interact with other parents through the Parent Teacher Organization (PTO)
2. Establish a network of community resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a comprehensive list of community resources including mental and physical health partnerships, food resources, and share as the need arises.
3. Increase family participation in decision-making	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Foster comfortable open dialog between families and school by utilizing all available resources and means of communication: “Dot sheet” for daily communication; E-Notes; Class website; Parent-Teacher Conferences; phone calls; email; weekly newsletter • Conduct annual Title 1 meeting providing information regarding federal programs expenditures • Elicit feedback on family-survey at end of year and use for future planning
4. Equip families with tools to enhance and extend learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Share learning activities with families through newsletters, E-notes, website, e-mail, and dot sheet • Offer parent-involvement opportunities though the Back to School Bash, Fall Festival, field trips, classroom and school volunteer opportunities • Provide access to individual student assessment data and available learning activities through the CLI Engage platform • Provide enrichment activities to do at home on weekly basis
5. Develop staff skills in evidence-based practices	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collaborate with counselor for poverty training and readings • Participate in the Customer Care Program encouraging positive family contacts
6. Evaluate family engagement efforts and use evaluations for continuous improvement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conduct an End of Year survey to evaluate progress toward goals and refine strategies
