### **ARP/ESSER Allocation Plan**

#### **ESSER III General Allocation = \$15,159**

Total allocation for partial salary of student support professionals to address interventions needed for students who experienced learning loss.

#### **Proposed Expenditures – ESSER III – Set Aside Allocation**

Target 1: Additional Learning Loss Funding - \$60,985

- Partial salary for student support professionals – mental health services and social services for students in day-school programs.

Target 2: After School Programming - \$12,197

- Partial salary for student support professionals for after-school interventions and social services.

Target 3: Summer Enrichment - \$12,197

- Partial salary for student support professionals to work with students providing mental health and related interventions and referrals.

Staff at the ROE Serving School will meet with principals, counselors, and other home school personnel outlining and seeking input regarding the RSSP COVID prevention and mitigation strategies to be used at the ROE Serving School program. In addition, the plans will be posted on the Regional Office website. The written strategies will be sent by mail to parents and guardians.

No ARP ESSER funds will be used for prevention and mitigation strategies.
