

VSP_{TM} Eyes of Hope Mobile Vision Clinic: June 9th & 10th from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Through VSP_{TM} Vision Eyes of Hope, qualified recipients can receive a comprehensive eye exam from a VSP network doctor and, if prescribed, high-quality glasses at no cost to you. Those requirements are:



- No vision coverage by a private insurer and/or government program.
- Meets the 2024 family income guidelines (size of family unit):
 - o 1 Person \$30,120
 - o 2 People \$40,880
 - o 3 People \$51,640
 - o 4 People \$73,160
 - For each additional person, add \$10,760 or visit aspe.hhs.gov/poverty-guidelines.

Clinic Day: June 24th from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. (continued)

The appointments will be free or low cost for families. Nurses are able to treat mild/moderate conditions, high blood pressure, diabetes, and more. Health screenings, physicals and vaccines can also be provided. Prescriptions will be given as needed. Middle Georgia Community Action Agency will be on site to assist with prescription resources. Medications will not be on-site and dental services will not be available. Register at Clinic Day Registration: English Form or Clinic Day Registration Form: Spanish Form.

Upcoming July Event: Back-to-School Tdap & MCV Vaccine Clinic: July 16th at 98 Cohen Walker Drive & July 17th at the LSSC from 2:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.

July 16th – Students from Perry High School, Veterans High School, Houston County High School, Perry Middle School, Bonaire Middle School, Feagin Mill Middle School, Mossy Creek Middle School, and Warner Robins Middle School visit the Houston County Department of Health for a drive-through clinic located at 98 Cohen Walker Drive. Register at 98 Cohen Walker Drive-Through Vaccine Clinic.

July 17th – Students from Northside High School, Warner Robins High School, Northside Middle School, Thomson Middle School, and Huntington Middle School can visit the Lindsey Student Support Center for a walk-in clinic to receive their vaccines through the Houston County Department of Health. Register at LSSC Walk-In Vaccine Clinic.

The deadline to register for both clinics is July 11, 2025.
