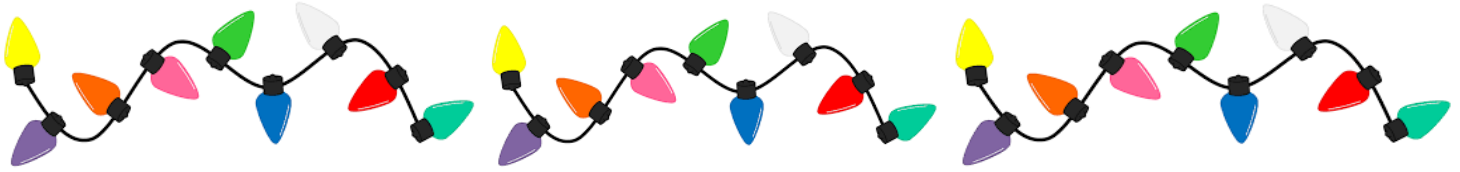


Mrs. Davis' Newsletter
