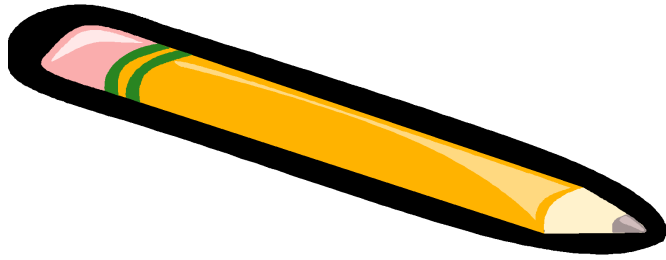

- 1.) Notebook paper as needed throughout the year.
- 2.) 2 pencils sharpened at all times. You may use regular or mechanical pencils. If using mechanical pencils make sure you have extra lead with you.
- 3.) A bradded 2 pocket plastic folder (best) or 1-1 1/2" binder . This will be your life line and will count as a test grade each 6 weeks.
- 4.) 5 dividers with tabs
- 5.) Red pens

- 6.) 1 Box of tissue
- 7.) 1 Disinfecting wipes

Geometry only:

- 1 Protractor
- 1 Compass
- 1 Clip ring
- 1 Package of Note cards (3x5 or 4x6)

***Composition book**- this is for notes. If you have the one from last year and it still has pages left...use it! But have a backup JIC. Kids **can use a spiral** but I have found that only the super organizers kids can keep the metal spirals from being squashed after the 1st 6 weeks. Squashed spirals lead to greater frustration.

*A **heavy duty 2 pocket folder**- Don't worry about brad's in the middle, just need 2 pockets (for daily and tests)

***Index Cards**- 2 packs of white and 1 pack of colored

No, seriously....writing utensils and paper FOR THE ENTIRE YEAR!! And I don't mind keeping them for the kids to be handed out when needed!! This is the main thing that kids CONSTANTLY do not have or keep track of so PLEASE help a gal out!

HIGHLY RECOMMENDED...HIGHLY!

A **corded (not Bluetooth) mouse**. They cost about \$5-7 on Amazon. Sometimes I have the kids do a lot of detailed work on slides or sheets. Having a mouse would be FANTASTIC! The reason why I do not suggest Bluetooth is the cost and once the tiny USB gets lost, the mouse is useless. (And if any parent or group of parents would like to gift a class set of 15 to me then I will SO SO take care of them and have them available for ALL my kids...and I will thank you profusely!!)

This is it. This is all I need your kiddo to have in ALL my classes every year. Simple but effective!

I supply markers, glue, colored pencils, colored paper, crayons, highlighters, rulers, and scissors, and pencil top erasers if needed. IF YOUR KIDDO likes to use lots of different colors of highlighters and pens (black or blue only for turning in work) then they will need to get those themselves.
