

Dear Parishioners,

Here is an edited and polished version of your message. I've made adjustments for clarity, grammar, and flow, while preserving your tone and theological depth:

Happy Corpus Christi Sunday!

This great feast invites us to reflect more deeply on the mystery of the Eucharist. It is not only a reminder of Christ's presence—it is His presence. In the Eucharist, Jesus Christ gives Himself to us as the Bread of Life, so that we may be incorporated into His Body, the Church. This is no mere symbol, but the profound reality of His true presence, hidden under the appearance of bread and wine.

We might ask, how can this be?

It is by the power and grace of God. In every Holy Mass, through the grace bestowed upon the priest, the gift of the Eucharist is made present. Where Christ is present, there the Church is formed. This is the great mystery we celebrate today, remembering the words of Jesus: "Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you." (John 6:53)

This feast also calls us to examine how we prepare to receive Him. We know that Christ is present in the Eucharist—but do we truly discern His presence? Do we truly worship His presence? What appears as bread and wine is, in truth, Jesus Christ. So we should ask ourselves:

- Do I avoid sin, concupiscence, and all that would separate me from God?
- Do I live in a way that is consistent with the teachings of the Church—especially regarding marriage, family life, and the dignity of human life?
- Have I prepared my heart through prayer and by observing the Eucharistic fast (at least one hour before receiving)?
- Do I receive Him with reverence—in how I dress, in my posture, and in the disposition of my heart?

If we honestly ask these questions, we will be better prepared to receive so great a Sacrament.

Finally, I encourage all of us to consider how we receive Jesus in the Eucharist. I highly recommend receiving on the tongue, or at the very least, receiving in the hand with utmost reverence, forming a throne with our hands for the King of Kings.

Let us adore Him, receive Him worthily, and allow His grace to transform our lives.

TRACY AREA GARDEN & QUILT TOUR


- The Tracy Area Gardens and Quilts Tour is fast approaching! It will be held on Wednesday, July 9 from 2-7:30.
