Student Dress Code TAYLOR COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT DRESS CODE POLICY FOR PRE-K:

The faculties and staff of the Taylor County Schools encourage all students to take pride in their personal appearance through good grooming and wearing of proper apparel. We are sensitive to the influence of fashion and style, but what is fashionable and stylish may not always be appropriate for school. We ask that our students wear adequate and modest clothing, including undergarments of such style and design that are consistent with our community standards. "Standard of Dress"

The school reserves the right to determine proper attire. Here at the Taylor County Pre-K we stress self-help skills. Please dress your child in comfortable, easily removable play clothes. Parents should use good judgment in seeing that their child dresses appropriately for school.

- 1. All student attire should fit properly and be properly zipped, buttoned, and belted.
- 2. No clothing should display certain symbols or logos that are inappropriate and disruptive to the learning environment.
- 3. Shorts should be of modest style and length.
- 4. No Athletic spikes, cleats, flip flops, light-up shoes of any kind or bedroom shoes.
