The State Board of Education annual training requirements:

\*Nine (9) hours training credit for veteran board members

\*Fifteen (15) hours training credit for new board members

To maintain Exemplary Board status each board member must complete an additional 3 hours training. (Exemplary Board Hours are:  $9+3=12$  veteran;  $15+3=18$  new)

Exemplary Board Requirement (as explained in GSBA criteria):

The State Board of Education annual training requirements are exceeded by a minimum of three additional credit hours for all Governance Team members. Additional credit hours will be considered from state approved and non-state approved training providers. Documentation of completed courses is mandatory.
