

Middle School Attendance Zone Changes

Middle Schools | 2027-2028 Proposal

How the Proposed Lines Were Drawn

The principles behind the proposal, drawn from the school-by-school changes.

1**Give Veterans Middle a zone of its own**

The new school opens with its own attendance zone, relieving the two largest middle schools — Bonaire (1,227) and Perry (1,138).

2**Follow boundaries families recognize**

Lines follow major highways, power lines, or stream corridors, so a family can tell which side of the line they live on.

3**Keep high school pathways unchanged**

High school zones do not change. Students moving into Veterans Middle remain zoned for Veterans High.

4**Fix feeder patterns with small moves**

This plan aligns attendance zones to closely mirror high school attendance zones creating stronger feeder patterns where possible.

5**Move as few students as necessary**

Changes impacts approximately 780 middle students district-wide; most Houston County families see no change.

6**Students who are enrolled at impacted schools**

Grandfathering, existing out-of-zone provisions and advance notice to families make the transition student and community friendly.

Grandfathering & Enrollment Planning

A key part of the plan is a student and community friendly transition for students and families.

Grandfathering

Students currently enrolled in an impacted school may request to remain at their current school rather than attend their newly zoned school.

*** Parents would be required to provide transportation.

Out-of-zone enrollment

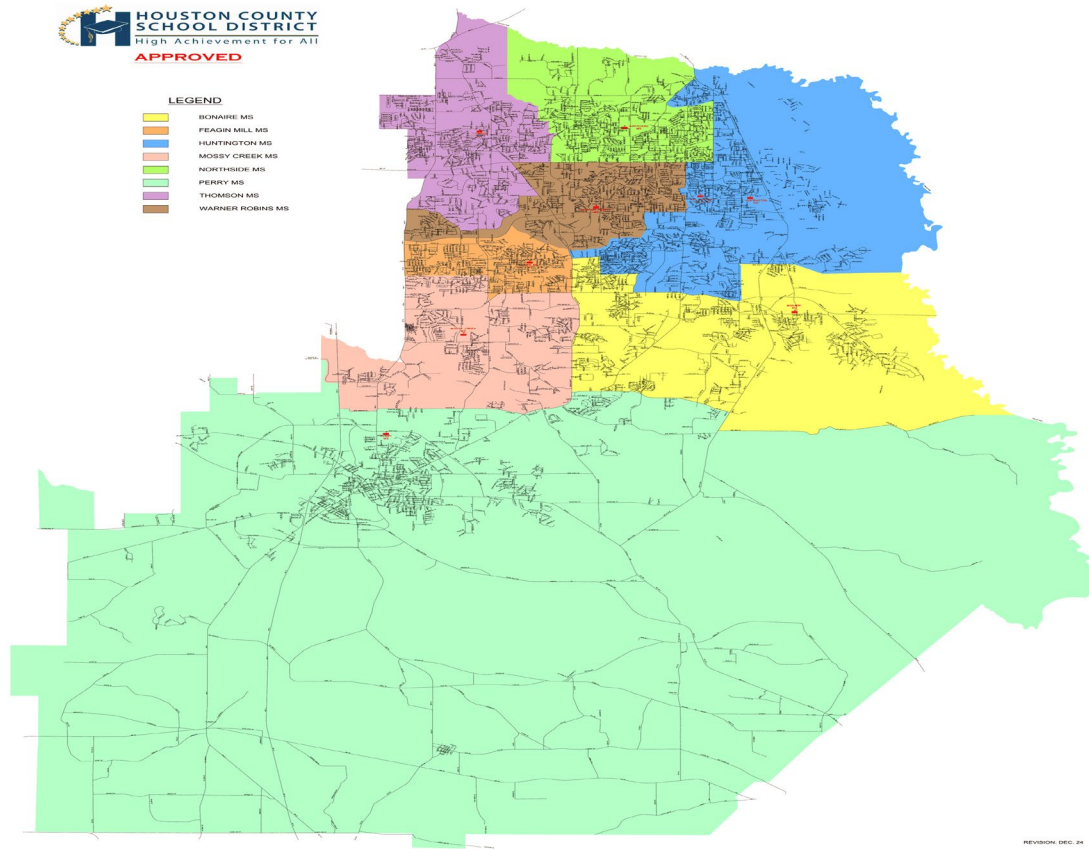
- **House Bill 251** — any family may request another HCSD school with available space; the family provides transportation.
- **House Bill 224** — active-duty military families who live on the installation may request any HCSD school with available space.
- **ELL and Special Education services** — students placed at a specific school to receive services.
- **Senior Privilege** — students finishing grade 4, 7, or 11 may complete grade 5, 8, or 12 at the same school after a move within the county.

Enrollment planning note: Projected enrollment includes the proposed zoned population and current out-of-zone students for planning purposes. Actual enrollment may vary based on grandfathering decisions and other enrollment provisions.

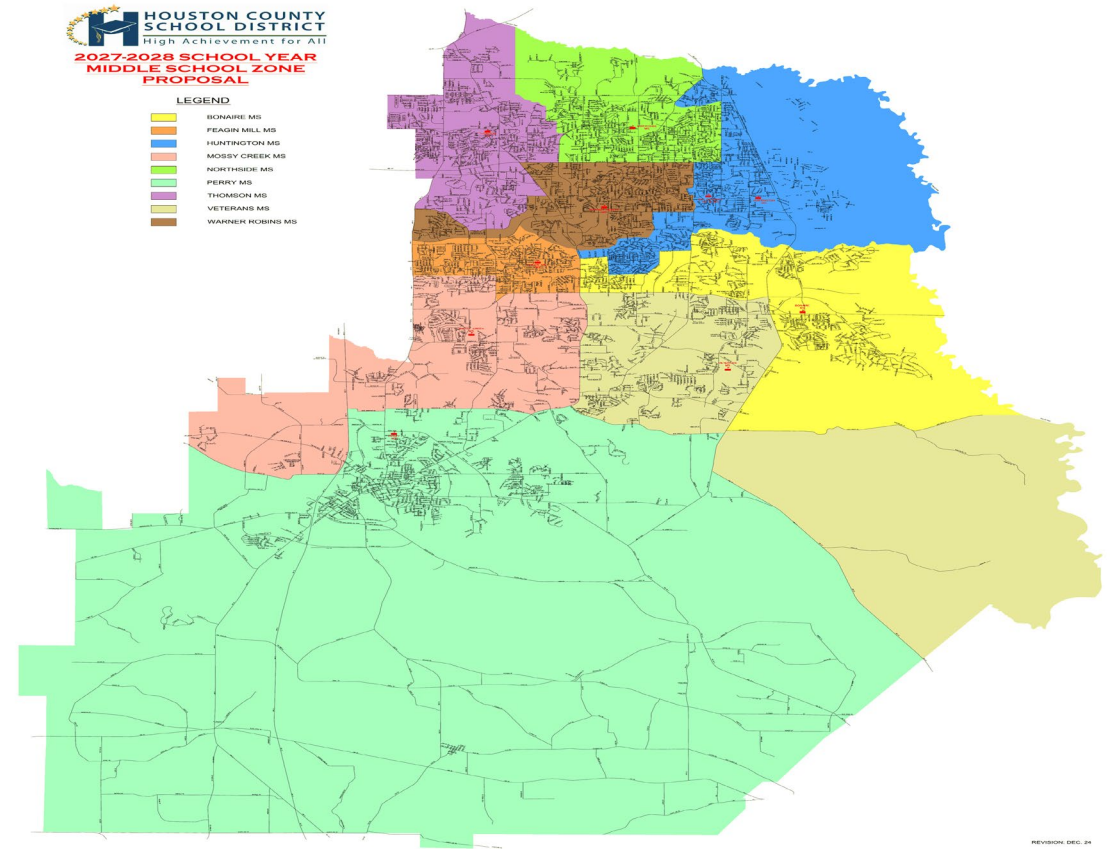
Middle School Zones: Current vs. Proposed

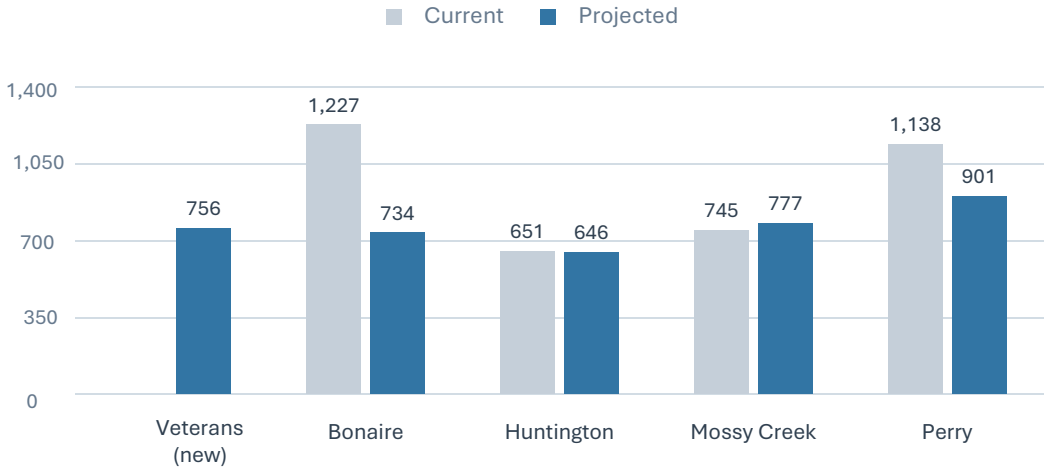

What the proposal does

- Creates an attendance zone for the new Veterans Middle School.
- Approximately 554 students move from Bonaire Middle to Veterans Middle.
- Approximately 202 students move from Perry Middle to Veterans Middle and 30 to Mossy Creek Middle.
- High school attendance zones do not change.

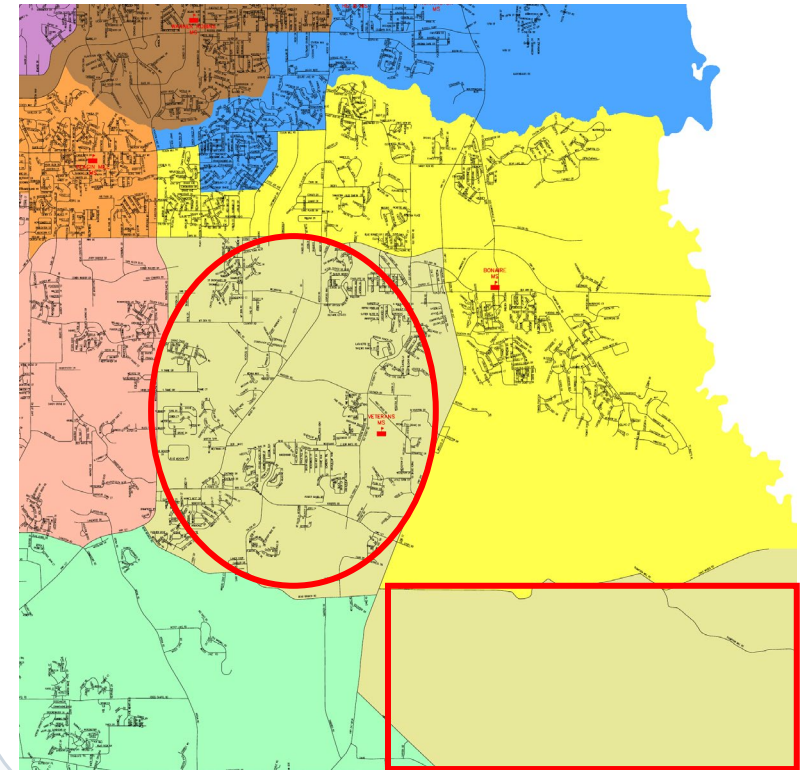

What changes

- New zone primarily south of Highway 96 between Houston Lake Road and Highway 247.
- Approximately 554 students come from the current Bonaire Middle zone.
- Approximately 202 students come from the current Perry Middle zone.
- Students remain in the Veterans High School attendance zone.

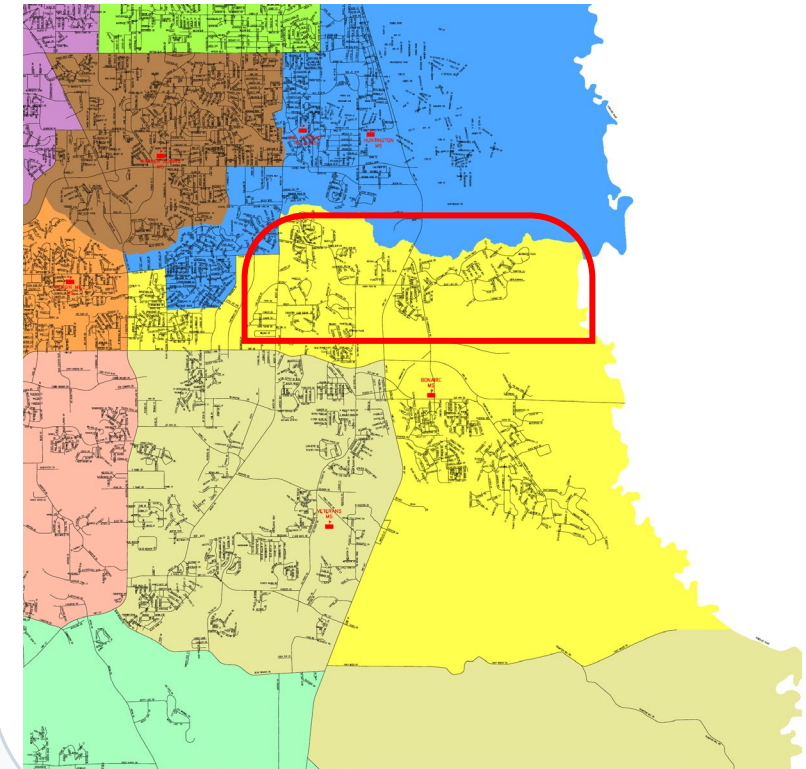
Net change

BMS has 91 current OOB. New projected enrollment will be 734.

What changes

- Students south of Highway 96 move into the new Veterans Middle zone.
- The northern boundary also adjusts along the stream corridor near Leisure Lake and Robins AFB.
- Students continue to feed to Veterans High and Warner Robins High.

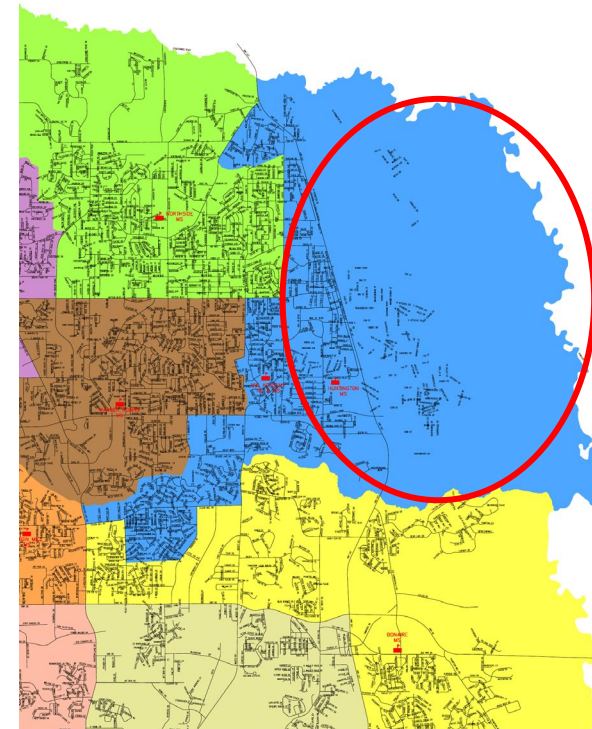
Net change

HMS currently has 29 OOB. New projected enrollment will be 646.

What changes

- Eastern and western boundaries remain the same.
- Southern boundary adjusts along Feagin Mill, Peach Blossom, Bonanza, Moody and the stream corridor toward Highway 247.
- Students continue to attend Warner Robins High School.

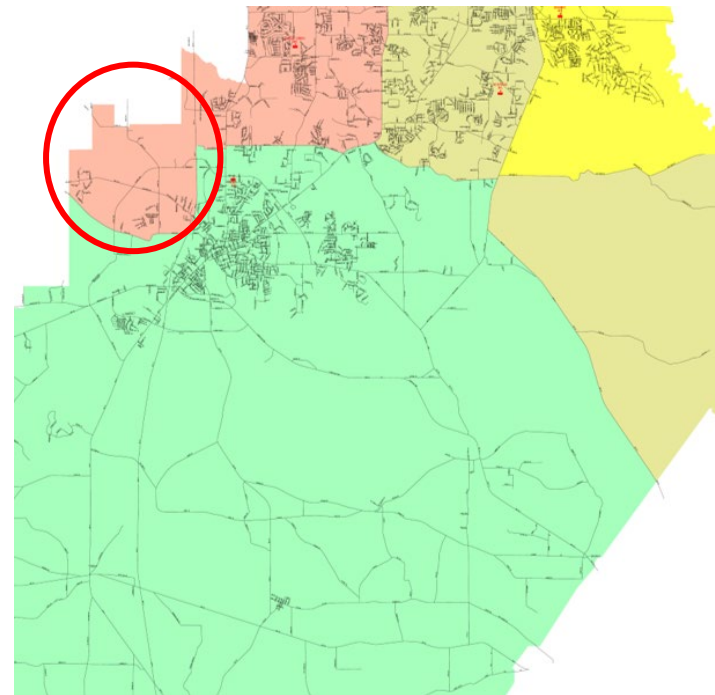
Net change

MCMS currently has 101 OOZ. New projected enrollment will be 777.

What changes

- Zone extends south on I-75 to Sam Nunn Boulevard, then west to Valley Drive and the county line.
- Approximately 30 students move from Perry Middle to Mossy Creek.
