

Paris City Schools Mowing RFP

- 1) Mow and trim (weed-eat) all school property, including:
 - a) Paris High School(Including Greenhouse Lot)
 - b) Paris Middle School
 - c) Paris Elementary School
 - d) Paris Early Learning Village
 - e) Singer Alley Property(Including student parking lot on 7th Street/weed-eat all Islands)
 - f) Houston Avenue Property
 - g) Bus Lot
 - h) 8th Street Sports Complex, including soccer field (but not the baseball or softball playing field)
 - i) Mow and trim the ridge above the PHS football field “high-wall.”
 - j) Blanton Collier Stadium (All areas inside fence/weed-eat all fence lines)
- 2) Spraying: with permission from Paris Schools, some areas may be sprayed instead of trim/weed-eating
- 3) Any contractor who selects to spray must have the appropriate state pesticide/herbicide applicator's license.
- 4) Work CAN occur during school hours, but NEVER within 100' of students or staff
- 5) Last Mow of the Year should include leaf removal.

Except where noted, mowing frequency should be “as needed” to keep the lawns looking very well-kept.

It is estimated that mowing would occur weekly during the prime growing season.

By submitting a bid, the contractor acknowledges that they are fully aware of the property boundaries and that all areas are included in their bid.

Paris Independent Board of Education will receive mailed proposals postmarked March 6th for Mow and trim (weed-eat) all school property. The Bids will be opened at the Paris Board of Education Office at 3:00 PM, Wednesday, March 11, 2026.

Sealed bids postmarked by March 6, 2026, should be mailed to the attention of Stephen McCauley, Paris Board of Education, 310 West 7th Street, Paris, KY 40361. Bids should be clearly marked “MOWING”. The Paris Board of Education reserves the right to reject any and all proposals.
