District Honors Teachers and Employees of the Year Announces Houston County Teacher of the Year, Mrs. Jessica Miranda



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – The Houston County School District honored 39 Teachers of the Year and six Employees of the Year during the district's Opening Session on July 27, 2021. At this event, the districtwide Teacher of the Year and four finalists were announced for the first time.

Jessica Miranda of Veterans High School is the 2021-2022 Houston County Teacher of the Year. Miranda has taught special education at Veterans High School for eight years. She earned a bachelor's degree from Columbia College in Columbia, Mo. and a master's degree in special education from The University of Phoenix. She and husband, Will, have two children. Outside of the classroom, she enjoys spending time with her family, crafting, cooking, reading and genealogy.

Mrs. Miranda said, "I am so blessed to work with this group of educators, and when I found out the theme this year is 'My Home, My Houston,' I really thought about what home means to me. Growing up an army

brat, when somebody asked me where I was from, I always said 'nowhere' or 'a little bit of everywhere.' It wasn't until we moved to Warner Robins and I started working in Houston County that I realized that Houston County is my home."

As the Houston County Teacher of the Year, Miranda received gifts valued at approximately \$15,000, including cash awards from the HEA Federal Credit Union, Houston Association of Educators, Robins

Regional Chamber, Sonny's BBQ, and Synovus Bank. She was also awarded a one-year lease of a new Honda from Hughes Honda.
