









#### NHSAS Proficiency Data Compared to NH State Average







#### Lin-Wood Middle School Overview








(Achievement by Gr 1-11 - NWEA Math)



(Achievement by Gr 1-11 - NWEA Language)




(Achievement by Gr 6-8 - NWEA Science)




(Growth Gr 1-12 - NWEA Reading)






