2. The following grading scales and indicators shall be used:

Kindergarten and First Grade have separate report cards. They use the following grading system:

O =	90-100
S+ =	80-89
S =	70-79
NI =	65-69
U =	0-64

S+	Satisfactory +
S	Satisfactory
NI	Needs Improvement
U	Unsatisfactory

All other subjects and grades, (grades 2-8), use the same reporting system. All report cards are distributed four times a year.

3. A grade of "Incomplete" will be given to those students unable to complete the work assigned to the course for reasons beyond the student's control, such as the student's disability.
- a. A teacher who submits a grade of incomplete will accompany the grade with a reasonable estimate of the amount of time the student will require to complete the work necessary for the granting of credit.
