Class of 2029 Latin Honors Distinctions

The class of 2029 will follow the Latin Honors system, granting Top Performing Students to be recognized with one of three honors distinctions at graduation:

Summa Cum Laude, Cum Laude, or Magna Cum Laude

1. To earn the distinction of *Summa Cum Laude* (with highest honor), a student must have earned a total weighted grade point average of at least 4.2000.

2. To earn the distinction of *Magna Cum Laude* (with great honor), a student must have earned a total weighted grade point average of at least 4.0 and less than 4.199.

3. To earn the distinction of *Cum Laude* (with honor), a student must have earned a total weighted grade point average of at least 3.8 and less than 3.99

All coursework offered by an accredited institution (including colleges) will be included when determining honors distinctions.




