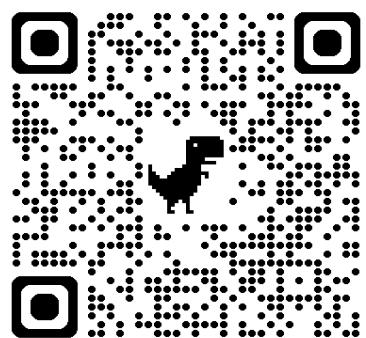

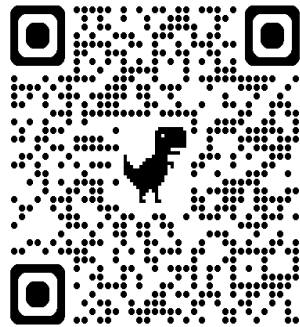



Latin Honors Distinctions

The class of 2029 will follow the *Latin Honors* system, granting *Top Performing Students* to be recognized with one of three honors distinctions at graduation:

Summa Cum Laude, Cum Laude, or Magna Cum Laude

1. To earn the distinction of ***Summa Cum Laude*** (with highest honor), a student must have earned a total weighted grade point **average of at least 4.2000**.
2. To earn the distinction of ***Magna Cum Laude*** (with great honor), a student must have earned a total weighted grade point **average of at least 4.0 and less than 4.199**.
3. To earn the distinction of ***Cum Laude*** (with honor), a student must have earned a total weighted grade point **average of at least 3.8 and less than 3.99**

All coursework offered by an accredited institution (including colleges) will be included when determining honors distinctions.

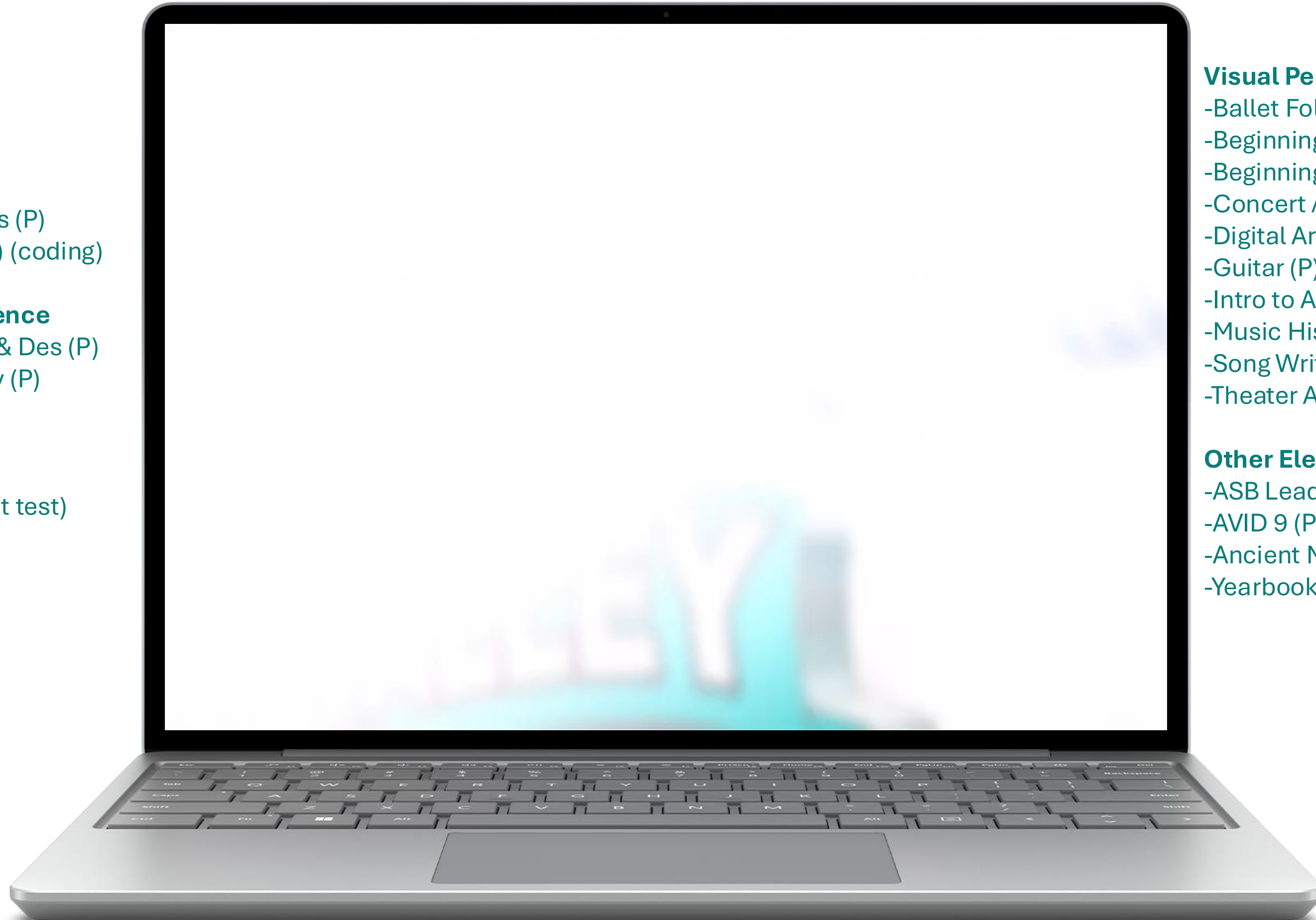

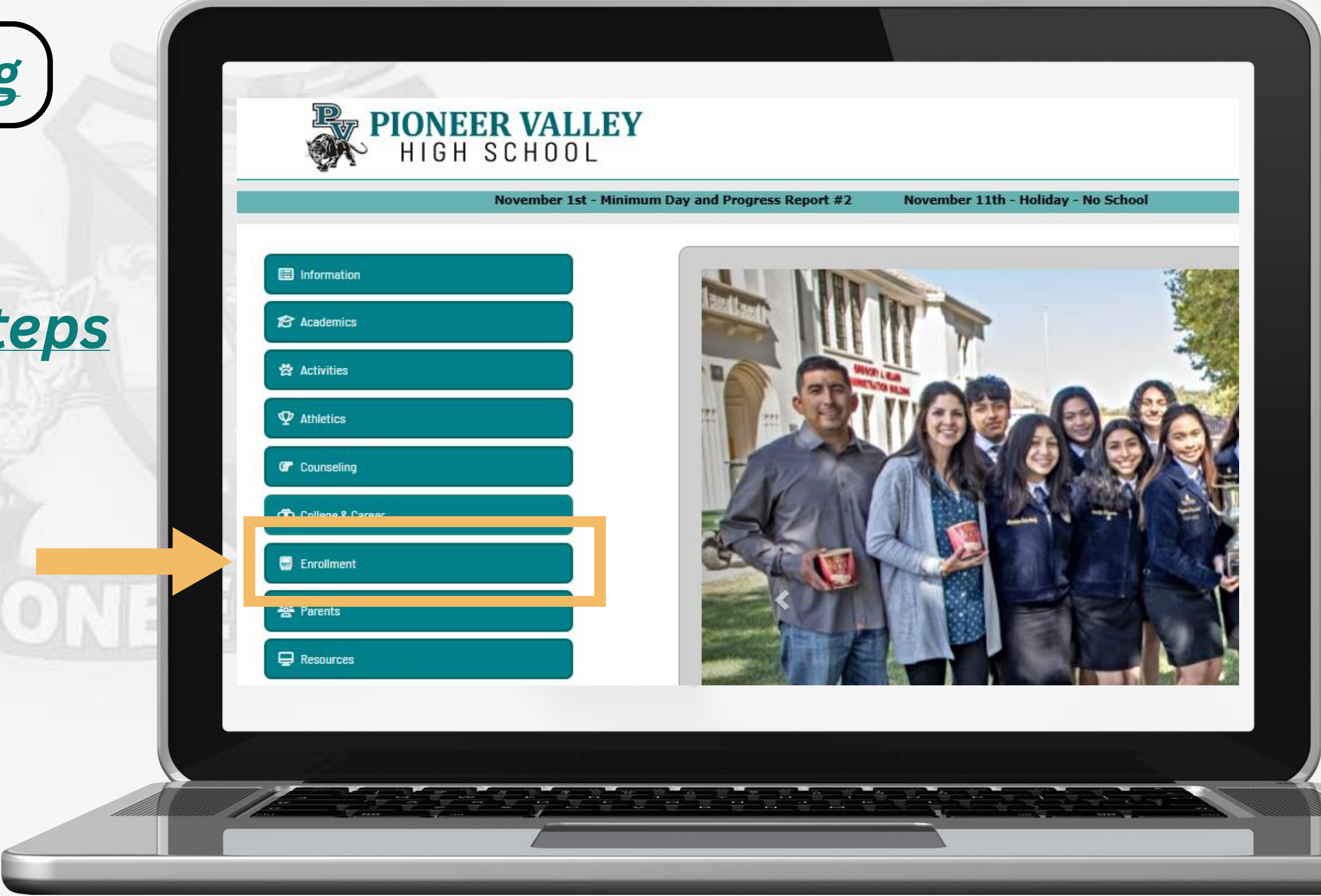

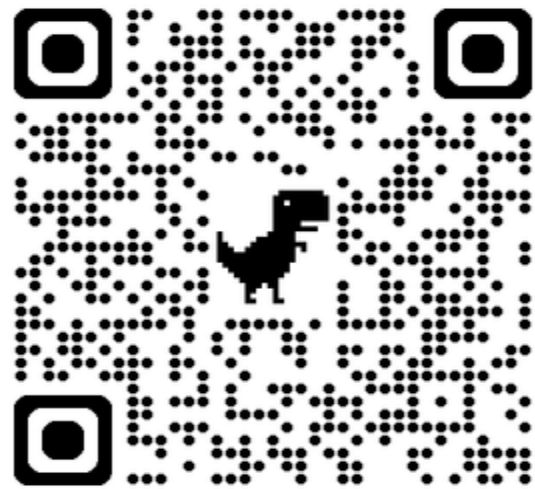
