Successes: This year, TSD has been randed as a high performing school. We continued to navigte the learning loss due to the Covid pandemic. This is our second year using a block schedule. The response to intervention was improved to include peer tutoring, after school help, and study table during lunch. The block schedule also includes a reteach section where students can acces their instructors for needed assistance. The ELA and Science results were our top subjects. Areas of Challenge: Math continues to be an area of opportunity for growth in both the 8th grade and 6th grade. Action Plans: The action plans for this year will focus on data analysis and using the assessments to inform instruction. The structure for the data teams is in place within the master calendar. The teachers will have opportunities to review and analysize student work samples as well as the alignment of the instruction. This year also addresses and enrichment period where students who have mastered a standard can now be exposed to additional instruction to deepen their understanding.
