In accordance with the rules and regulations governing public schools in the state, and in order to provide appropriate educational services to migrant and non-migrant students, this agreement is hereby entered into between the parties listed below:

The Administering Agency agrees:

- To provide guidance and technical assistance for ICON Migrant Program Contact Persons
- To make final eligibility determination for enrollment in the ICON Migrant Program
- To provide ICON Migrant Program instructional materials for eligible students enrolled in the ICON Migrant Program
- To score all tests and provide District/Agency with written evidence of students completed work
- To provide District/Agency with Recommended Grade Report of students completed work
- To maintain student file with evidence of eligibility, work completed and Recommended Grade Report

The Serving District/Agency agrees:

- That students eligible for the ICON Migrant Program will be served by District/Agency
- That the District/Agency will grant credit based on the Recommended Grade Report

This agreement shall commence on the date of signature and remain in effect, inclusive of all summer school activities.

Description of ICON Migrant Program Services:

ICON Migrant Program courses will only be available to migrant students who are currently or previously eligibility for participation in the Migrant Education Program.

Students determined eligible for the ICON Migrant Program shall receive applicable course materials and supplies consistent with ICON Migrant Program procedures and guidelines. Students will meet on a periodic basis with the District/Agency ICON Migrant Program Contact Person. Upon completion of each ICON Migrant Program course, a Recommended Grade Report will be sent to the District/Agency showing completion of each unit and the average grade of students work.

Charges:

There is a \$35/Student charge for eligible migrant students to enroll in a new course.

There is a \$20/Student charge for eligible migrant students to continue a course from summer term.

District/Agency Requirements:

To participate in the ICON Migrant Program, the school district/Agency must comply with the following:

1. Identify a District/Agency ICON Migrant Program contact person
2. Enroll the student through the secure portal providing the COE and courses needed
3. Provide secure way to transmit final grade information

Agreement Review:
