PSSA and Keystone Testing:

PSSA testing is a state requirement for all students in grades 3 - 8 and will take place at SAMSS on April 25th, 26th, and 27th for ELA; May 1st and 2nd for Mathematics,: and Science will test on May 4th for 8th grade students only.

We encourage all students to be present in the buildings on all of the testing days and to be on time; arriving at the building no later than 7:25 a.m. Students should be well rested and eat a fitting breakfast prior to the test.
