It is an honor to represent your school and classmates as a member of court. With this honor comes responsibility. Behavior and dress must be in accordance with Central High School's Code of Conduct and policies, as well as Board of Education policies established by Carroll County Schools.

Official Dress

<u>Homecoming Court Ladies</u> are asked to dress in formal attire, such as a prom dress or formal, dressy floor-length gown, or pantsuit. Dresses must be approved by Mrs. Martin for Friday night's presentation.

<u>Homecoming Court Ladies Escorts</u> should dress in a suit and tie, or shirt and tie, with shirts tucked in. Dress shoes with socks and a belt are expected. **No blue jeans or tennis shoes please.**

<u>Homecoming Court Men</u> are asked to wear a suit and tie, or a shirt and tie, or a pants suit. Shirts should be tucked in. Dress shoes with socks and a belt are expected. **No blue jeans or tennis shoes please.** Note: Football players may wear uniforms due to the game that evening.

<u>Homecoming Court Men Escorts</u> should dress in a nice appropriate length dress and/or dress pants with a nice dress shirt. Dress shoes should be worn. **No blue jeans or tennis shoes please.**

<u>Ladies: The new football field surface is rubber and not intended for stiletto</u> pencil size heels. NO PENCIL OR STILETTO STYLE SHOES ALLOWED!
