What is Title I?

Sharp Creek Elementary is identified as a Title I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I is designed to support State and local school reform efforts tied to the challenging State academic standards to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support family engagement. All Title I schools must jointly develop with parents and family members a written parent and family engagement policy.



School Plan for Shared Student Achievement

What is it?

This is a plan that describes how Sharp Creek Elementary will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning. Sharp Creek Elementary values the contributions and involvement of parents and family members to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes the different ways that Sharp Creek Elementary will support family engagement and how parents can help plan and participate in activities and events to promote student learning at school and at home.



How is it revised?

Sharp Creek Elementary School invited all parents to attend our annual School Forum last spring to review and revise this parent and family engagement policy, as well as the schoolwide plan, our school-parent compact, building staff capacity, and the family engagement budget. Additionally, parent input and comments regarding this plan are welcome during the school year through an online form. The plan is posted on our school website for parents to view and submit feedback throughout the year. All parent feedback received during the year will be used to revise the plan for the next school year. We also distribute an annual survey online to ask parents for their suggestions on the plan and the use of funds for family engagement. Who is it for?

All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Sharp Creek Elementary School will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents and family members with limited English, with disabilities, and of migratory children.

Where is it available?

At the beginning of the year, the plan is included in the student handbook that is given to all students. The plan will also be posted on the school website and social media. Parents can also retrieve a copy of the plan in the Parent Resource Center in the Conference Room.

2025-2026 District Goals

The percentage of students scoring at Proficient or above on the Georgia Milestones (GMAS) English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science End of Grade Assessments will increase by 3%. The percentage of students scoring at Proficient or above on GMAS in subgroup categories of economically disadvantaged, Students with Disabilities, and English Language students will increase in each area by 6%.

2025-2026 School Goals

In addition to our district goals, we will focus on the increase in Reading & Math STAR performance.

We will focus on implementing "Walk to Interventions" for phonics instruction in 3-5. In grades k-2 we will implement Saxon Phonics skills for mastery.

Focus:

K-5 will focus on ELA/Reading by working on the main idea, key details, and phonics instruction.

K-5 will focus on numbers and Operations in math.

English Language Learners, Economically Disadvantaged, and Students with

Disabilities will receive additional support, materials, and strategies in the area of reading/ELA and math.

Each year SCES surveys parents, students and staff to gather information about Sharp Creek Elementary. This information is used to guide the School Improvement Team in developing a School-Wide Title One Plan. In addition, SCES holds a Parent and Stakeholder Input Meeting to gather direct feedback from parents on the School-Wide Title One Plan, Title One Budget, School Compact and Parent and Family Engagement Plan. We also routinely survey parents about different opportunities for them to be involved in our school and continued family engagement activities to promote school/community partnerships.
