Covid-19 Mitigation Strategies

Mitigation Strategies

1) Promoting vaccination

Achieving high levels of COVID-19 vaccination among eligible students as well as teachers, staff, and household members is one of the most critical strategies to help schools safely resume full operations.

2) Consistent and correct mask use

Mask use is highly recommended rather than required for students, staff and visitors in district buildings. Mask use is required for all students, staff, and others on school buses and other public transportation. Mask use is not recommended while outside.

3) Physical distancing

Maintain at least 3 feet of physical distance between students within classrooms, cafeterias and buses.

4) Ventilation

PUSD adheres to CDC and other regulatory bodies as it pertains to standards to limit the spread of Covid19.

5) Handwashing and respiratory etiquette

Teach and reinforce handwashing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Remind everyone in the facility to wash hands frequently and assist young children with handwashing. If handwashing is not possible, use hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol. Hand sanitizers should be stored up, away, and out of sight of young children and should be used only with adult supervision for children under 6 years of age.

6) Staying home when sick and getting tested

Daily screen by email and at Time Clock to ensure no staff comes to campus feeling ill. Education for parents and guardians to keep students home if ill. If a student exhibits Covid-19like symptoms, then notify Campus nurse or administrative assistant for direction. Do not send student to nurse's office.

7) Screening testing to promptly identify cases, clusters, and outbreaks

Performed by District Response Team. DRT will coordinate with the local health department. PUSD has rapid Covid-19 test available for staff and students.

8) Contact tracing, in combination with isolation and quarantine

Performed by District Response Team. DRT will coordinate with the local health department.

9) Cleaning and disinfection

Teachers will disinfect desks after each class. If a facility has had a sick person or someone who tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 24 hours, the DRT will be responsible to clean and disinfect the space.
