




Mississippi's accountability system assigns "A" through "F" letter grades for schools and districts. Grades are based on student achievement, student growth, student participation in testing, and other academic measures. COVID-19 pandemic disruptions continue to be reflected in 2021-2022 accountability data, particularly growth data. Growth calculations for some high school students required measuring growth from the 2018-2019 school year, and overall student performance on assessments improved since the first full year of pandemic-era schooling in 2020-2021. Additionally, students did not have to pass end-of-course high school

assessments in 2020-2021, which affected the 2021-22 graduation rate.



Measurements of student performance on the statewide math assessment.




English


Measurements of student performance on the statewide English language arts (ELA) assessment.




