## **DRESS CODE**

All clothing or garments should be clean and in good repair. The body and hair should be well groomed and clean. Any apparel that will expose the back, midriff, or the chest of any student is not acceptable on school property during school hours under normal conditions. This also includes any type of style of tube tops or extreme styles. Shorts or skirts must extend below the fingertips when arms are extended to the side (Grades 5-8). Shoes must be worn at all times for safety and health. Any clothing or jewelry that has obscene wording, suggestive wording, or insinuates something physically offensive, and any apparel that advertises unhealthy products will not be acceptable. Jeans with holes in them above the knee are not acceptable.
