1. <u>huddled</u> : to gather close together in a bunch
2. <u>safety</u> : freedom from harm and danger
3. <u>gathered</u> : to come together or assemble
4. shelter: to provide cover or protection from; shield
5. <u>observed</u> : to see or notice
6. <u>merchant</u> : a person whose business is buying goods or selling them for profit
7. <u>timber</u> : wood that is used to build things
8. <u>fetched</u> : to go after and bring back
9. <u>platform</u> : a raised, flat surface

10. <u>admired</u>: to look at or speak of with appreciation or pleasure
