1. huddled: to gather close together in a bunch
2. safety: freedom from harm and danger
3. gathered: to come together or assemble
4. shelter: to provide cover or protection from; shield
5. observed: to see or notice
6. merchant: a person whose business is buying goods or selling them for profit
7. timber: wood that is used to build things
8. fetch: to go after and bring back
9. platform: a raised, flat surface
10. admired: to look at or speak of with appreciation or pleasure
