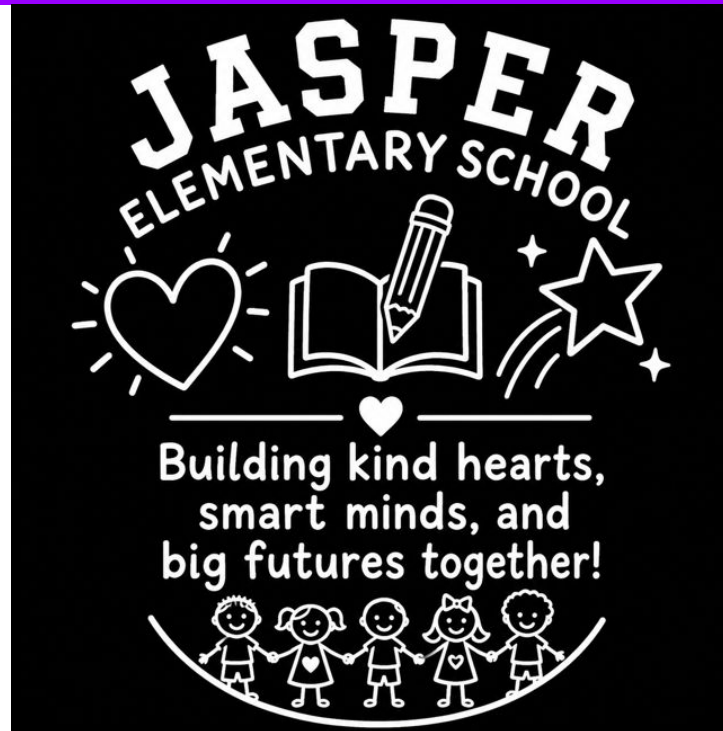

 - 3rd and 4th grades @ 3:00

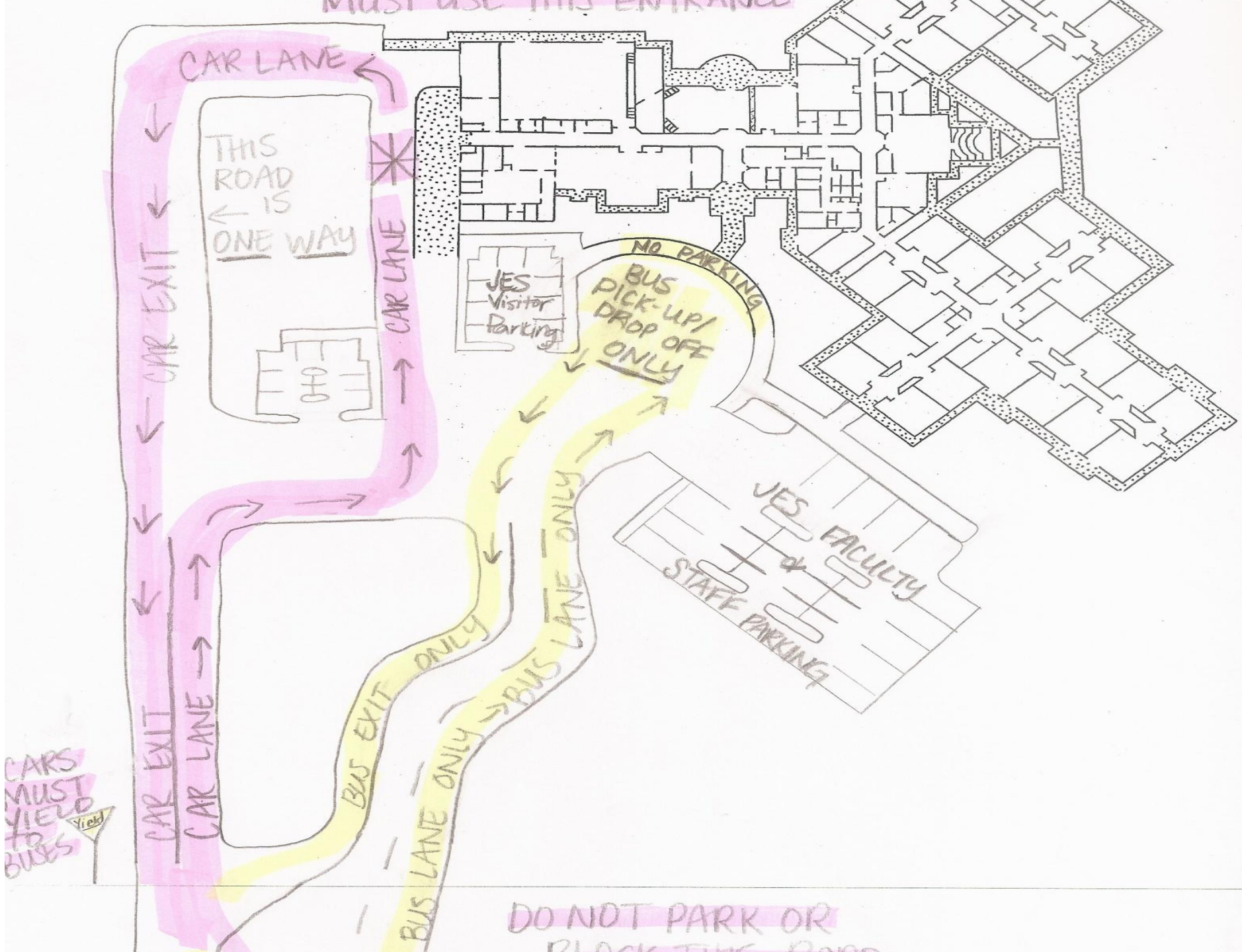


All students picked up by 3:15. (Buses leave as they arrive starting around 2:55)

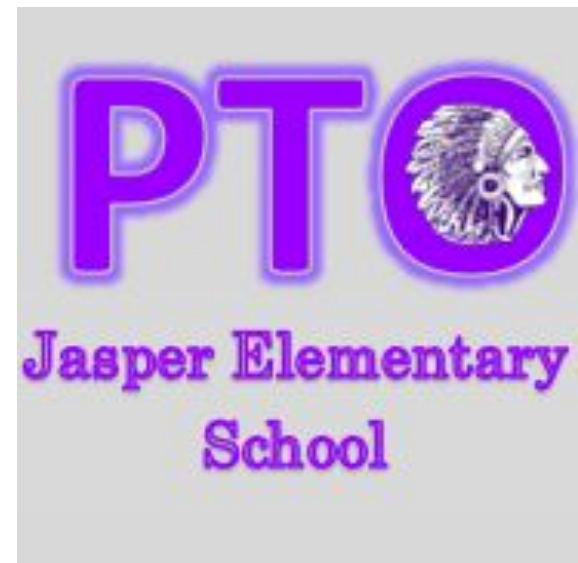

TITLE I Information

- Title I is a federally funded program that has been in place since 1965.
- Developed to assist schools with a high percentage of socio-economically disadvantaged students by giving additional funding in order to provide high-quality education for every child.
- Jasper Elementary is a Title I school.
- Marion County Title I services: teacher and paraprofessional salaries, funding for equipment and materials, and professional development.

Breakfast and Lunch



NO COST breakfast and lunch for all students!

Your child WILL need money if they want additional items (milk, veggie, ice cream) OR if they bring a lunch from home and want items.

Starts later - 1st - 4th grade students have the opportunity to buy ice cream on Fridays and one other day per week. \$0.75

Kindergarten gets to buy ice cream one day per week.

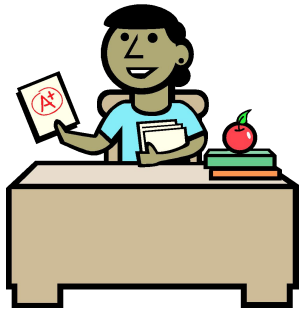
Breakfast/lunch visitors will not be permitted.

- **Will start on Monday, August 10**



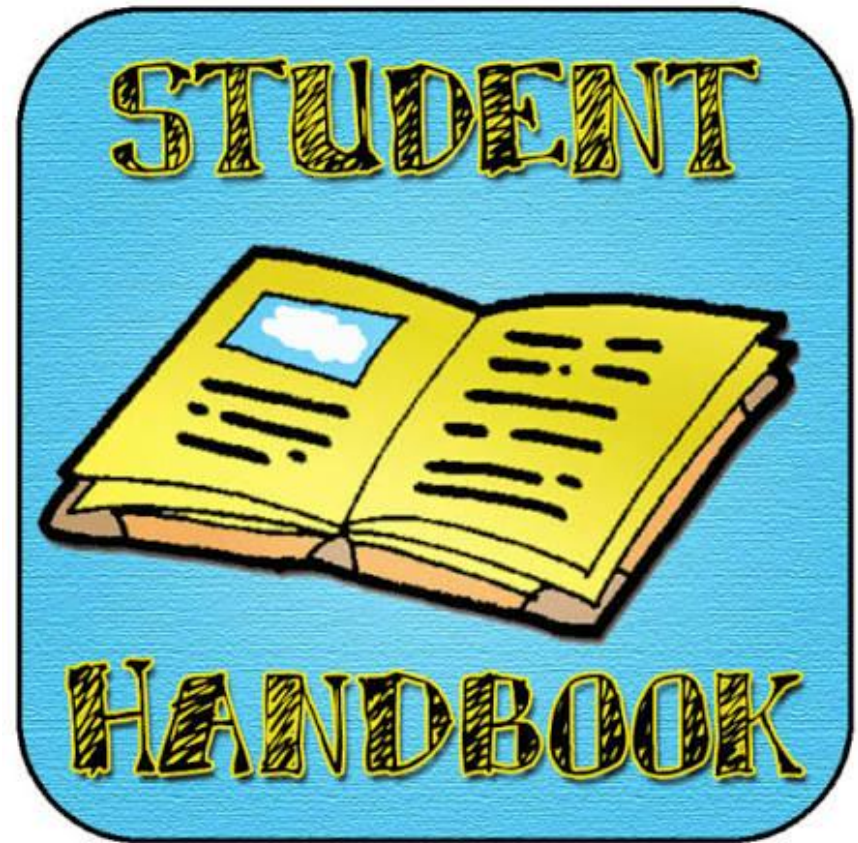
Supply List and Room Donation

Attendance Updates

***First 6 absences excused**

***Doctor's notes must be in within 3 days or they will not be accepted**

***absences categories: excused or unexcused**

-difference: truancy (legal matter) or not

-same: missed instruction

***Tardies: be here by 7:55; car rider door closes at 7:55**

***Sickness - must be fever/vomiting/diarrhea free for 24 hours before returning**
