BULLYING AND CYBERBULLYING (SEE SUMMARY CODE OF CONDUCT-- APPENDIX D)

Bullying or Cyberbullying of a student by another student is strictly prohibited.

Bullying among children is defined as a variety of negative acts carried out repeatedly over time. It involves a real or perceived imbalance of power, with a more powerful child or group attacking those who are less powerful.

Cyberbullying is an attempt to display power and control over someone perceived as weaker and may occur on campus and off school grounds. It may involve student use of the district internet system or student use of personal digital devices

Incidents of suspected bullying should be reported to Mr. McCauliffe for investigation.

Retaliation for reporting bullying is prohibited as well.
