Piedmont High School Parking Pass Policies & Procedures

ELIGIBILITY:

Students must have a valid driver's license.

Students must have current insurance on the vehicle.

Students must have cleared all financial obligations with the school.

Students may be denied the privilege to park based upon attendance issues, discipline issues, and/or parking/driving incidents.

REQUIREMENTS:

All students who are granted the privilege to park must have their parking permit displayed properly in their vehicle. All students will be issued a student parking permit and must park in the student lots only. Students are not allowed to park along curbs, on fire lanes, or in the faculty/visitor parking lots.

LOSS of PRIVILEGE:

Student behaviors including, but not limited to, the following list may result in loss of parking privileges for the remainder of the current school year and/or the ability to park during the following school year. Students found to be in repeated violation may have their car towed or booted until compliant with PHS parking requirements.

- Excessive unexcused tardies / absences
- Multiple parking violations
- Failure to meet financial obligations within reasonable period of time
- Excessive vehicular noise (i.e. loud music, exhaust)
- Dangerous driving in the parking lot including excessive speed
- Any other reason the administration deems unsafe or disturbing to the welfare of others

NON-REFUND POLICY:

If a student loses the privilege to park on campus during the year, he/she is not eligible for a refund of parking fees.
