This Week's Agenda

Spelling: CVCe Syllables (also known as 'magic e' or 'silent e' words/syllables – we are learning that silent e not only makes a vowel long, but it can also make 'c' and 'g' say their soft sounds.

Reading: We will read and write about stories discussing the importance of school **Math:** We will continue learning about place value and the importance of the position of a digit in a given number – 81 versus 18

Practice At Home

Each week, I will send home a half-page paper that says "UFLI Home Practice" at the top. This is an overview of our weekly spelling pattern, some examples of words that follow that pattern, and some word work you can practice with your child. It will also notify you of the irregular words I am introducing that week. These are high-frequency words that your child will be expected to read on sight. I will also send home a reading log at the beginning of each month (beginning this week). This is the only homework that I am requiring students to complete and turn in at the end of each month. Finally, I'll send home some math practice that reflects what we are learning in class.

Again, the only thing that students are required to complete and turn in is their monthly reading log. The rest is just a resource for you to help your kiddo practice at home.
